

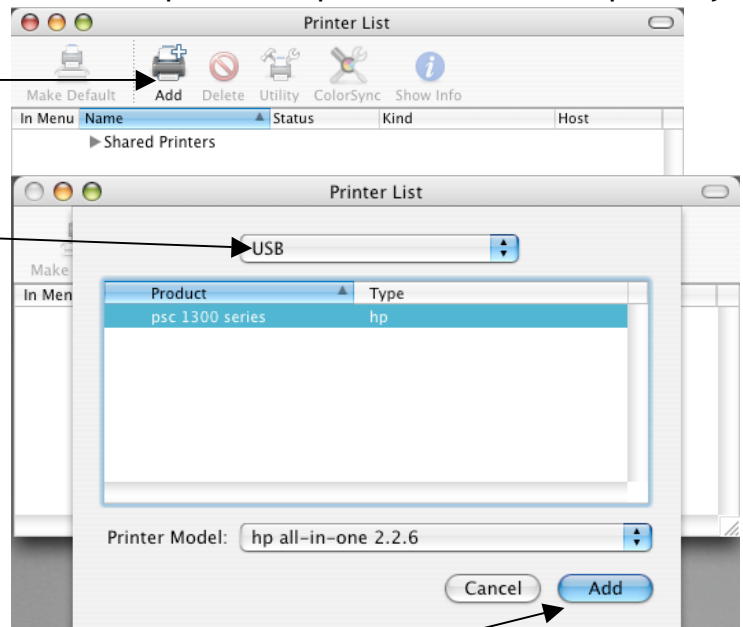
## PRINTING TO A USB PRINTER AT HOME

1. To be able to print from your home printer, you must:
  - **HAVE A PRINTER THAT IS MAC OSX COMPATIBLE.** Some printers work only with PC's and will not work with your iBook.
  - Your printer must be a USB printer.
  - The appropriate Printer Drivers must be installed on the iBook. There are many printer drivers already installed on the iBook. If your printer driver was not on the iBook last year, it may be on it this year.
2. Connect your iBook to your printer and power on the printer. Open the Printer Setup Utility (the printer icon in the Dock).

3. Click **ADD** on the Printer List window.

4. In the Add window, select the type of printer from the 1<sup>st</sup> drop-down menu list. Choose:

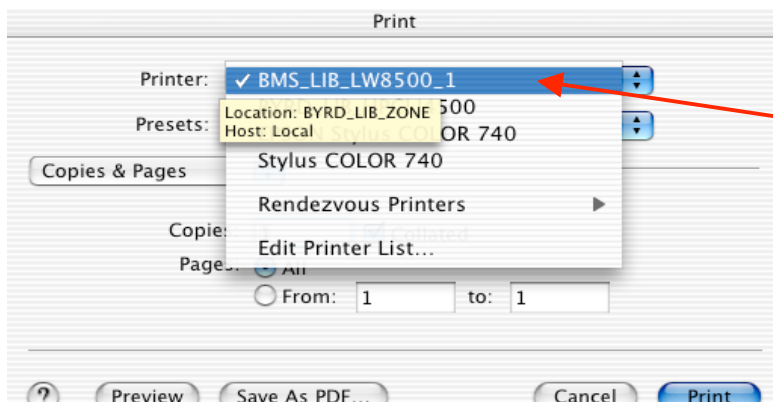
- Epson USB if you have an Epson brand printer
- Lexmark Inkjet Networking if you have a Lexmark brand printer
- USB if you have another type of USB printer. The drivers for your printer may already be installed- even if you do not see the brand name of your printer in the list.
- Rendezvous if you have a printer hooked up to a wireless network (some of the newer airport base stations support wireless printing)



Your printer name should automatically show in the Printer Setup Utility window. Click on the printer to select it and click **Add**.

*If your printer does not show in the list, you may need to have printer software installed. OSX has many printer drivers installed. Please check to be sure your printer software is installed making an appointment with the Help Desk to install it. **PRINTER DRIVERS ARE INSTALLED AT THE HELP DESK BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.***

6. When you are ready to print your document, select **File menu > Print**. As soon as you get to the print screen, **BE SURE THAT YOU HAVE SELECTED THE CORRECT PRINTER.** Click on the drop down list to select your printer. If your printer does not appear in the drop down list, you will need to add your printer in Printer Setup Utility.



The currently chosen default printer has a checkmark beside it. Select the printer you wish to print on.
